### PLEASE HELP SAVE LIVES & PROPERTY

As the operator of a motor vehicle, we know you appreciate the true life and death realities associated with following the rules of the road. Since so many crashes occur as a result of speeding, the City of Hamilton hosts a mobile photo enforcement vehicle at various locations around our community to help ensure the safety of motorists, pedestrians and cyclists. This program is known as the Hamilton Focus on Safety Program.

The Hamilton Focus on Safety Program uses an automated mobile camera system to detect speed violations. A speed violation consists of a vehicle traveling at a speed greater than the posted speed limit. The vehicle is detected automatically and the camera system records images of the vehicle and surroundings.

On each image of the violation is the date, time, location, posted speed limit and the vehicle's speed when the violation occurred.

The vehicle registered in your name and described below appears to have exceeded the speed limit. Such action violates the Hamilton City Code 343 (Photo Traffic Enforcement System).
