


## GENERAL INFORMATION FOR DISPOSING OF LARGE OR UNUSUAL ITEMS

**Yard Waste:** Yard waste is now picked up with your trash on the same day, at no additional charge. Yard waste can be placed in your City or Rumpke-issued trash cart, in a 35-gallon can clearly marked “yard waste” or in paper yard waste bags for collection. Yard waste collection is limited to 6 containers per week. Brush should be bundled in sizes no more than 4 feet in length and 2 feet in diameter. Limbs should not exceed 6 inches in diameter and must weigh less than 75 pounds. This service runs every second Saturday from April to October at the City’s Water Reclamation Facility at 2451 River Road from 8:00 a.m. to Noon. The City does curb side collection of leaves once every fall – check the city website in the fall ([www.hamilton-city.org](http://www.hamilton-city.org)) for times and locations.




**Appliances: Freon Appliance** Pick Up is available at no charge through Butler County Recycling from April through October. Check with Butler County Recycling at 513-887-3653 for program information. Appliances with Freon removed by a certified HVAC contractor and stamped Freon Free can be placed out with regular garbage collection after calling Rumpke at 513-867-8661 for a large item pick up.

**Monitors or TVs** –Televisions (with tubes up to 32" and LCD and Plasma televisions up to 60") and computers can also be recycled at Best Buy in Bridgewater Falls for a fee. Cohen Hamilton will also accept computer towers call 513-863-3474 for details. Habitat for Humanity ReStore, 896 Fairview Ave, will accept computer towers and monitors, call 513-893-1102 for details.



**Hazardous Waste:** Hazardous waste should not be placed in regular trash. Butler County Recycling offers a free drop off from June to September call 513-887-3653 for more information. Used automotive fluids (such as motor oil) are accepted at most oil change service locations, and automotive supply stores.

**Old Paint:** Latex paint can be donated to Matthew 25 Ministries (513-793-6256) or Habitat for Humanity (513-893-1102). If disposing of old paint it must be opened and allowed to dry. Cans less than half full and still wet can be filled with kitty litter and let sit until dry. Once dry, leave the lid off and place with regular garbage for pick up. Rumpke will not accept any cans that are sealed.



**Large Items Disposal:** Up to 2 large items such as couches, chairs, dressers, mattresses, etc. can be put out with weekly garbage collection. Call Rumpke at 867-8661 to arrange for a no-charge large item pick up.

**Construction Items:** No construction items can be placed for regular garbage collection including plaster, roofing, lumber, dry wall, fencing etc. Construction debris can be taken to the Hamilton Transfer Station at 1000 North Third Street and disposed for a fee. Call 867-8661 for details.



**Tires:** No Tires will be accepted in regular trash pick-ups. Butler County Recycling sponsors a free tire drop off event every fall. Call 887-3653 for details.
